Log Exchange (LX) is a multipurpose debugging tool for the SBC 1000/2000, SBC 5000 series, and VX series gateways.

LX parses log files and displays SIP call flows, ISDN call flows, and advanced call details in real-time - making it easy for end-users to analyze and troubleshoot issues.

When using the SBC 1000/2000, users have the ability to parse log messages on the fly using LX's built in Syslog listening capabilities.
